## WELSH-LANGUAGE PUBLISHING GRANTS

### GRANTS FOR BOOK LAUNCHES AND SIGNING TOURS

#### **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- 1 The offer of grant is made on the basis of the information contained in the application and in any supplementary correspondence. The publisher must inform the Welsh Books Council promptly of any expected changes. The grant paid may vary according to the final costs.
- 2 The grant recipient shall comply with any additional conditions and scheme requirements specified in the formal offer of grant or in any covering letter.
- 3 The books promoted must have been supported through one of the Welsh Books Council's grant schemes.
- 4 The books promoted must be sold in all supported events by an acknowledged bookseller.
- 5 The bookseller must receive stock of the titles to be promoted through the Books Council's Distribution Centre.
- 6 The stock must reach the Distribution Centre at least three working days before the launch.
- 7 Writers' fees cannot be paid through this scheme.
- 8 If the purposes for which the grant has been offered are not fulfilled in due time, or if the relevant conditions have not been complied with, the Welsh Books Council may cancel the grant offer or require the recipient to return all or part of any grant which may already have been paid.
- 9 The Publisher for himself (and others) covenants with the Publishing Grants Panel and their successors in title that he the Publisher will at all times hereafter save harmless and keep indemnified the Panel from all proceedings costs claims and demands in respect of any act that might result in the breach of any of the laws of England and Wales.
